

## **Guidelines for authors**

### **“Food regulation and trade: institutional framework, concepts of analysis and empirical evidence”**

**Text format/software:** Please use MS Word, paper format DIN A4, 15 pages maximum. For running text, the **fonts** Times New Roman (**font size 11, line spacing: 1,5 lines**), and for titles and headings the fonts Arial (**Line spacing: 1,5 lines**) should be used. If you like, you can choose the template we’ve created.

#### **Titles and subtitles:**

The following levels of titles/headings may be used:

The title of the contribution should always appear at the top of a new page.

1 Title of the chapter (**Arial, 14 pt, bold, spacing before: 12 pt,**)

1.1 First-level heading (**Arial, 12 pt, bold, spacing before: 12 pt**)

1.1.1 Second-level heading (**Arial, 12 pt, italics, spacing before: 12 pt**)

Third-level heading (**no number, Arial, 12 pt, italics, spacing before 12 pt**)

Please not use footnotes for references (citation in the text) but only for limited explanations etc.

- Three or more authors: (MILLER ET AL. 1995)
