PATH TO ZERO DEFORESTATION? MITIGATING CATTLE-DRIVEN **DEFORESTATION IN THE BRAZILIAN** AMA70N

POLICY BRIEF AUTHORED BY AFECOS!

Our colleagues Constanze and Thao have published, together with Dominic Suri, a policy brief in ZEF. The brief tackles the pressing issue of cattle-driven deforestation, which still accounts for over 70% of forest loss in the Brazilian Amazon. despite existing measures such as the G4 Cattle Agreement and the Deferred Prosecution Agreement.

The key takeaways are:

- Enhancing Transparency: Strengthening supply chain transparency by leveraging traceability platforms (e.g., Trase, Do Pasto ao Prato, SeloVerde) to boost consumer awareness.
- Expanded Commitments: Broadening zerodeforestation commitments with enforceable stakeholder penalties and improved coordination to maximize the impact of current agreements.
- Strengthening Farmer Capacity: Simplifying compliance processes and providing farmers with the necessary tools and training for sustainable cattle farming.
