Other expenses related to the Study Programme

Students interested in taking a preparatory **language course** prior to the start of their first or second academic year or during the academic year can sign up for a language course at a cost ranging from 250-500 Euros depending on the university. Students are not required to take such a language course, but are recommended to do so.

For each of the two mandatory **summer schools**, the AFEPA coordination office may charge a fee of 300€ per student to cover expenses related to the renting of the venue, inviting guest speakers, and organizing field trips and social events. This fee does not cover travel and accommodation for attending these summer schools. The summer school fees are paid to the AFEPA coordination office prior to the beginning of the summer school.
