- Potential for top tier publications (e.g., high quality working papers, achievement of best paper awards and recognitions, at national and international level)
- Knowledge of survey methods, data collection, quantitative methods and behavioral economics evidenced by participation in research projects, working papers or publications in the abovementioned areas.
- Computer skills and knowledge of statistical /econometric software and methods
- High proficiency in English and German;

Contract Duration: initially 36 months starting as early as January 2020

Salary: 42,000€ year (plus scientific allowance t.b.d.), Teaching Load: 60h / acad. year
