

Stipends for young researchers

The EAAE offers 10 and the GEWISOLA with the support of the Rentenbank offers 5 stipends to support conference participation by young researchers from the list of eligible countries found below. Applicants who hold their PhD for longer than five years are not considered young researchers. Each stipend consists of a **lump sum of 1.000 €** to cover the conference fee and part of travel and accommodation costs.

You are eligible, if you

- have a PhD degree obtained within the last five years or be currently doing a PhD,
- have a confirmation of approved contribution (will be checked by the stipend committee),
- a professional affiliation / employment at an institution in one of the countries listed below,
- are a member of the EAAE (must be provided before latest at the submission deadline – 31st May 2025).

The eligible countries are based on the purchasing power corrected per capita GDP. Applications are welcome from: Albania, Armenia, Belarus, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Estonia, Georgia, Greece, Hungary, Kosovo, Latvia, Moldova, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Serbia, Slovak Republic, Turkey and Ukraine.

If you want to apply, you have to provide the following:

- The [application form](#) including all details requested,
- A proof of professional affiliation / employment at an institution in one of the countries listed above signed or confirmed by your supervisor,
- A proof of enrollment in a PhD program or confirmation of PhD candidacy or a proof of PhD holders that their degree was obtained within the last five years,
- Number of submission (paper, poster abstract or contribution to an organized session).
- A proof of your EAAE membership (must be provided latest at the submission deadline – 31st May 2025).

Deadline for application: 31.05.2025

Selection procedure:

The decision on the scholarship is made by the Local Organising Committee at the University of Bonn. If the number of applicants exceeds the number of available stipends, the points awarded for their conference contributions will be used to rank the applications. Additionally, balance in terms of

geographical origin and gender is considered in the case where there are more applications than scholarships available.

Please note the [Stipend Terms and Conditions](#) which apply in the event of approval of a stipend and become the basis of the stipend contract between you and the EAAE or you and GEWISOLA.

Applicants will get informed about the decision within two weeks of the application deadline.
