For our new Collaborative Research Center (CRC 1780) “**Food System Diversification for Sustainable Nutrition**” (**FoodDiverse**), funded by the German Research Foundation (DFG), we are recruiting for the following positions to start as soon as possible, initially for three years with the option to extend:

24 doctoral researchers & 8 postdoctoral researchers in the broader field of sustainable food systems

All positions are in TV-L pay grade 13 (65% for doctoral and 100% for postdoctoral researchers). The FoodDiverse CRC analyzes relationships between diversification at various food system levels (e.g., agriculture, markets, diets) and planetary health in Germany and Ghana, in close cooperation with the University of Ghana. The researchers come from various disciplines (e.g., agronomy, agricultural economics, sociology, environmental sciences, ecology, nutrition, human health) and are integrated into 21 different CRC projects (see www.zef.de/fooddiverse).
