

The Faculty of Agriculture, University of Bonn is seeking to appoint a full time

Professorship (W3) "Entrepreneurship and Innovation Management in Agribusiness"

to be filled as soon as possible.

The professorship is associated with the faculty's new Institute for Entrepreneurship.

We are looking for candidates with a distinguished record of internationally visible scientific contributions to the management of innovation processes and the development of new business models. Applicants must demonstrate publications in leading peer-reviewed journals focusing on bioeconomic value chains of the agricultural, forestry and food industries.

We expect a convincing motivation and ability to participate in existing (e.g., PhenoRob Cluster of Excellence) and future collaborative research programs of the university, e.g. in the context of the Transdisciplinary Research Area "Technology and Innovation for Sustainable Futures" (TRA6). Willingness to conduct cross-faculty and interdisciplinary research is explicitly desired.

Experience in the acquisition and coordination of third-party funded projects is required. Individuals in an early career phase, or with experience outside the academic sector, who demonstrate excellent achievements in research and teaching, are also encouraged to apply. Teaching responsibilities in the field will be in the Bachelor and Master programs offered by the faculty. The co-design and further development of training and transfer activities of the Bonn Transfer Center enaCom in the field of entrepreneurship are expected. Teaching shall be conducted (if necessary after a training period) in German and in English.

The hiring requirements are in accordance with § 36 of the Higher Education Act of North Rhine-Westphalia (NRW).

The University of Bonn is committed to diversity and equal opportunities. It is certified as a family-friendly university and has a dual career service.
